1. MIPS will increase 4 year cohort graduation rates by 10% from the 21-22 to 22-23 school year.

- 2. Improve overall student growth index value for all subjects to 50% by 2026.

- Percentage of Students who Met or Exceeded their Projected RIT Score
 - K-6 Math: <u>30.6%;</u> 7-12 Math: <u>42%</u>
 - K-6 ELA: <u>31.9%;</u> 7-12 ELA: <u>36%</u>
